(1) Use Google.com to search for "overeaters anonymous" +scmi (use the "plus" sign) in the SEARCH box.

If it's easier to remember, you also may use the Word "overeaters", then the "plus" sign followed with a space and the town where you go to your meetings (ex: overeaters +ingham). In any case, the search will result in a hit for the South Coastal MA Intergroups's home page.

(2) Also, oaregion6's "Intergroup Massachusetts" listings page links back to us. [We are in the "home" pages of comcast.net]

From that point; while navigating our 4 other pages- you can access any information about OA you need – from meeting locations and times near and far, to online and telephone meeting information, to upcoming events, to the Region and World Service web sites, to order forms for literature and conventions, and opportunities to make donations.

Additionally, you will be able to read any recently archived correspondence from our Intergroup and have the capability of writing messages to the Intergroup board as a whole or individual IG board members. In short, the web site offers one click access to everything OA.

Of course we still want to see you at meetings to share face to face recovery, hope and fellowship.

If you need information or some contact with the program immediately; however; the South Coastal MA Intergroup web site is an ever-available tool – ready for you 24-7-365.
