2. If necessary, in the Registration / Change Forms area choose "U.S. Group Registration Change".

3. Fill out the online form then press the "continue" button. After checking over the information press the "confirm" button. Alternatively you could print out the PDF version and mail the completed form to OA World Service at the address indicated. Note that changes take up to three weeks to be included in OA World Service meeting lists.

know about the change and we will update our meeting list immediately as a courtesy.
